We provide free legal consultations for low-income San Francisco residents, and low-income residents of any county who are facing deportation. Please bring proof of your income and any documents related to your questions.

At your appointment, we will provide legal advice, informational materials, and referrals to other agencies if appropriate. **We do not guarantee legal representation or additional services.** We may provide additional services, as described below:

- **DEPORTATION:** Legal advice for immigrants in deportation proceedings; possible legal representation for immigrants in detention.
- **DACA:** Form preparation for SF residents.
- **GREEN CARDS:** Form preparation for SF residents.
- **FAMILY PETITIONS:** I-130 form preparation for SF residents. If the I-130 has already been approved and your relative is applying for a visa abroad, we will refer you to another agency.
- **CITIZENSHIP:** Form preparation for SF residents who are over the age of 60 or have a disability. In other cases, we will refer you to a citizenship workshop.

We usually do not provide assistance with applying for visas abroad, extending tourist or other temporary visas, or applying for asylum. We will refer you to another agency.
